SCIENCE

Note: Do the work in a thin notebook.

Q1. Collect the materials namely baking soda, flour, pepper, turmeric, rice, dal, salt, oil, sugar, ink, eno, lemon juice, milk, sand. Mix each of these in separate glasses of water. Notice which materials are soluble and which are not. Tabulate your observations in your notebook.

Q2. Take some bread or orange peel. Sprinkle water on some pieces of bread and keep them in a warm place in a closed container. Keep some pieces in sunlight in an open container during the day. Observe all the pieces after four days and answer these questions.

- Which of the pieces have become dry?
- Did the fungus grow on the pieces kept in sunlight?
- Which of the pieces have spoiled?
- Does water present in food encourage the growth of microorganisms?

Q3. Arrange the following food items according to the place of proper storage

Vegetables, potatoes, onions, tomatoes, fruits, sugar, fish, pulses, milk, cheese, salt, biscuit, butter, curd, rice, eggs. Draw and colour.

4. Varnish with clear nail polish or glue for shine.
