Q1. Model Work

Students should be able to speak a few lines explaining their model.

Materials such as cut-outs, drawings, or waste materials may be used.

Examples:

Nouns: car, tree, dog, book, school

Proper Nouns: India, Delhi, Taj Mahal, Riya

Q2. Project Work (A3 Sheet)

Topic: Compound Words

Paste or draw pictures to show how two words combine to form a compound word.

Example: butter + fly = butterfly

The project should be properly labelled.

Use double-sided tape so it can be easily displayed on the board.

Q3. Writing Practice

Complete cursive writing in the cursive writing book (Page No. 10 to 22).

Maintain neatness and proper formation of letters.

Q4. Reading & Recitation

Read simple poems and practice reciting them with proper actions and expression. Focus on topics like hygiene and good manners.

Q5. Learning Work

Revise all the work done in the notebook and textbook.

Prepare thoroughly for the Unit 1 Examination.

Q6. Sentence Making

Write one new word daily and make a meaningful sentence.

Do this work in a thin notebook.

 2. On the "screen" (top half), draw your favorite game or a picture of yourself.
 3. On the "keyboard" (bottom half), use bottle caps or small paper squares to create the keys (A-Z, 0-9, and Spacebar).
 4. Use a piece of string and a small sponge to create a "mouse" and attach it to the side.

Chart Work: Parts of a Computer

Task: Create an A4 or A3 sized colorful chart showing the main parts of a computer.

- **Details:** Draw and label the **Monitor, CPU, Keyboard, and Mouse.**
- **Fun Fact:** Next to each drawing, write one sentence about what it does.
 - *Example:* "The Mouse helps us click and point."

PAINTING

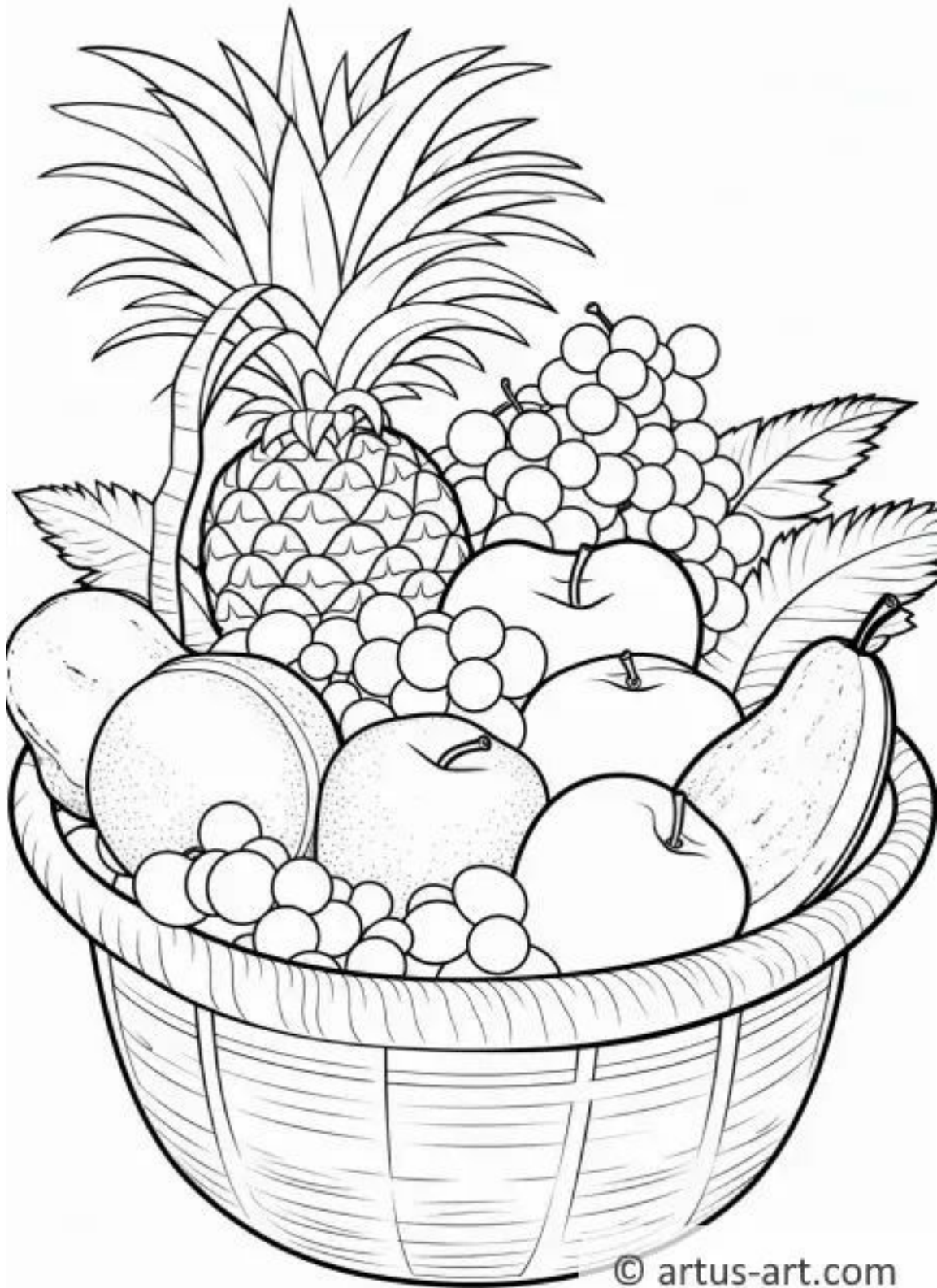
Q.1- Paper Tearing Collage – Butterfly*
