

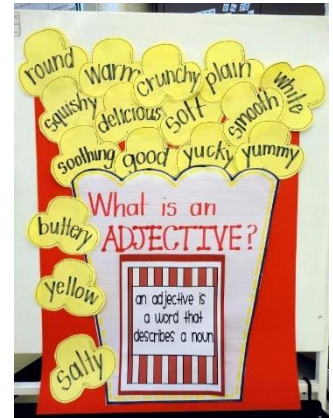

Q6. Practice Work

Practice addition, subtraction, and multiplication sums daily to improve accuracy and speed.

PAINTING

Q.1- Pattern Animals – Zentangle Turtle*

What to do: Draw a big turtle outline. Divide the shell into sections. Fill each section with different patterns: dots, lines, zig-zag, spirals. Color lightly.

Materials: A4 sheet, black pen, pencil colors

Q.2-Paper Plate Lion Mask*

What to do: Take a paper plate. Cut out eyes. Paste yellow/orange paper strips around the edge for mane. Draw nose, whiskers, mouth. Punch holes, add string to wear.

Materials: Paper plate, colored paper, glue, string, scissors
